## Unloc Ambassadors Recruitment Pack

Being an Unloc Ambassador gives you the opportunity to represent and showcase Unloc. This is an exclusive opportunity for those part of the Unloc Community. *Unloc Community includes every young person who is currently or has previously participated in an Unloc programme.*

This is a brilliant opportunity to have your voice heard and help shape the future of Unloc. You will have the chance to attend events all over the UK, these could be events run by Unloc or representing Unloc at events run by other organisations. As an ambassador, you will receive training to help you thrive in the role, such as leadership and facilitation skills.

## **What will I have to do as a Unloc Ambassador?**

Attend 3 training sessions over the year which are held usually 5 pm - 7 pm on Google Meet on a week day.

You will then have access to be able to pick and choose which events and programmes you would like to attend/support based on your availability. We ask that every ambassador will aim to attend at least 2 events each throughout the year. We will support you by finding different events that Unloc are attending or running that need support and ensure that you can attend depending on location. Travel expenses will be covered by Unloc.

- Have previously completed any Unloc project
- Are invested in Unloc's mission & values
- Are enthusiastic about attending events
- Are interested in working with children and young people
- Are willing to Champion Unloc
- Are wanting to network with industry adults
